

U.S. gasoline price decreases for first time in six weeks (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell for the first time in 6 weeks to \$2.35 a gallon on Monday. That's down 4.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
