U.S. gasoline price decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.22 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.59 a gallon, up 2-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.01 a gallon, down 4-tenths of a penny.
