

U.S. gasoline price increase for first time since August (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose for the first time since August to \$2.34 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
