

U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.40 a gallon on Monday. That's down 15.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.70 a gallon, down 13.4 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 2.18 a gallon, down 15.2 cents.
