

Gasoline prices decrease nationally for first time in 4 weeks (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell for the first time in 4 weeks to \$3.33 a gallon on Monday. That's down half a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
