Gasoline prices continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.38 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.57 a gallon, up 5 ½ cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.18 a gallon, up 9.3 cents.
