

Gasoline prices increase for first time since February (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose for the first time since February to \$3.54 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.8 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
