U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$3.35 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast region at 3.68 a gallon, down 5.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast States at 3.11 a gallon, down 2 cents.
