U.S. gasoline continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.33 a gallon on Monday. That's up 6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the New England region at 3.55 a gallon, up 2.8 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain States at 3.10 a gallon, up 4 1/2 cents from a week ago.
