Residential heating oil price increases

The average retail price for home heating oil rose 6-tenths of a cent from a week ago to \$2.18 per gallon. That's down 79 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$2.13 per gallon, unchanged from last week, and down 88 cents from a year ago.
