Residential heating oil price virtually unchanged

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1-tenth of a cent from a week ago to \$2.13 per gallon. That's down 76 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$2.07 per gallon, down 2-tenths of a cent from last week, and down 78 cents from a year ago.
