Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 8-tenths of a cent from a week ago to \$2.42 per gallon. That's down \$1.03 from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$2.37 per gallon, down 2-tenths of a cent from last week, and down \$1.04 from a year ago.
