Residential heating oil price increases

The average retail price for home heating oil rose half of a cent from a week ago to \$2.40 per gallon. That's down 2.6 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region rose to \$2.33 per gallon, up 6-tenths of a cent from last week, and down 3.4 cents from a year ago.
