Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1.5 cents from a week ago to \$2.36 per gallon. That's down 97 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$2.31 per gallon, down 2-tenths of a cent from last week, and down 96 cents from a year ago.
