Test of Energy News Radio Service

This is a test audio file of the U.S. Energy Information Administration's energy news radio service to be launched on Tuesday, September 11th with the release of EIA's monthly Short-Term Energy Outlook.

EIA's radio service will provide free short broadcast stories on EIA energy data reports and analysis to radio stations nationwide. The stories will be recorded in MP3 format and can be downloaded from EIA's radio service webpage at <u>www.eia.gov/radio</u>.

The first broadcast stories will be posted around noon Eastern Time on Sept. 11 after the release of EIA's monthly Short Term Energy Outlook forecast. These initial stories will focus on the outlook for U.S. gasoline prices, crude oil production and natural gas production.

Each broadcast story will be just under 1 minute in length and will include comment from an EIA analyst.

Stations can sign up at the EIA energy news radio service webpage for an RSS feed to receive the latest broadcast stories automatically or subscribe to an email list for notification about the release of new stories.
