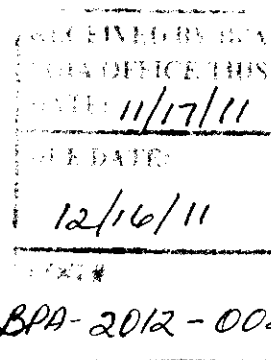

Description of Request: From a previous FOIA we know that BPA stopped including comments received after October 2010 for inclusion in the DEIS for the I-5 Project, so the delay of the DEIS cannot be attributed to those as BPA has had over a year to address the concerns in those comments. This request is for all the "unprecedented volume of public comments" received after October 2010 that have caused BPA to delay the DEIS process by up to six months and will now be included and addressed in the DEIS. Even though these comments maybe publicly available, BPA has not provided a method to identify which they are considering nor are they searchable by date nor are they date stamped.
