Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was received in this office on Wednesday, May 30, 2012, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2012-01416-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You have requested the following:

“John Day – McNary Transmission Line Project Wilson Construction Structure 59/4. Dates: 8/30/10 - 9/15/10 Inspector Name: Luke Hatfield and any other inspector who was on site during this time and specifically on structure 59/4. Please forward all inspector notes, correspondence and photos related to this structure and its change from drilled pier foundation to grillage.”

A telephone conversation with your office clarified that all the Daily inspector reports and notes for the period of 8/31/10 to 9/31/10 had already been provided under FOIA request BPA-2012-00942. All project photos had also been released under that previous request. Those items were withdrawn from this request.

This request then is for all documents related to the John Day – McNary Transmission Line Project structure 59/4 change from drilled pier foundation to grillage.
