This is a final response to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

#### You requested:

The existing and past members of the board of directors of the Bonneville Environmental Foundation Renewable, Inc. (BEFR).

### **Response:**

BPA conducted a search for any responsive agency records. Three were found. One of the responsive records is a copy of the BEF Board Minutes, which you indicated that you did not want or need. The second document is a BEF Board Memo that was sent to BEF for review and comment under Exemption 4.

BPA has determined after review that there is no privacy interest in the release of the names of board members identified in the BEF Board Memo. We are providing the responsive document which contains a partial list of board members. All other information has been redacted as non-responsive.

The one other responsive record is exempt from disclosure under Exemption 3 of the FOIA 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3). In this particular case, the document is prohibited from being disclosed by 5 U.S.C. app. § 107(a) (Ethics in Government Act of 1978). This statute prohibits an agency from disclosing confidential financial disclosure records of certain government employees.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may appeal within 30 days from the date you received this letter to The Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington D.C. 20585. The appeal must be in writing and both the envelope and letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
