Generally, these include accounts payable checks that haven't been cashed for reasons like (a) the payee moved without notifying you, (b) the payee disappeared, and (c) the payee has not cashed the check(s) for any other reason.
2. List of any other government agency that issues checks on behalf of your agency.

financial information that could be considered privileged or confidential.
