Thank you for your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office on Tuesday, March 1, 2011, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2011-00753-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You have requested a summary of all BPA supplemental labor contracts in effect in FY 2010 and FY 2011 showing:

1. The total number of full-time supplemental labor employees at BPA in FY 2010.
2. The total number of part-time supplemental labor employees at BPA in FY 2010.
3. The name of the supplemental labor contractor.
4. The general subject matter of the services.
5. The date the agreement with the supplemental labor contractor was signed.
6. The date the agreement expires
7. The total dollar amount of the agreement.
8. The dollar amount paid by BPA in FY 2010.
9. The maximum dollar amount BPA is obligated to pay in FY 2011.

We have reviewed your letter and have determined that it addresses all the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA and the DOE regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. You have agreed to pay \$50 in charges related to the FOIA.
