This is a final response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You have requested the following:

“I would like the dates of all the times the Castle Rock – Lexington line have been cleared or trimmed by BPA brush/tree trimming crews for the past 20 years.”

Response:

BPA has performed a reasonable search and found the following records:
