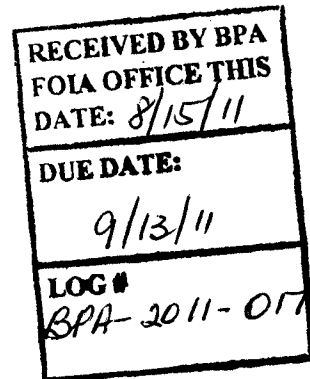

Re: Freedom of Information Act Request / Augspurgen Mountain Towers

Dear Ms. Munro:

I am the attorney for Robinson Bros. Constr., Inc. ("RBC"), in connection with its involvement as a subcontractor to Intelpoint LLC ("Intelpoint"), on a Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA") Project ("the Project"), under a Contract, known as "Augspurgen Radio Station Fiber Upgrade", BPA Contract No. 00048810. The BPA/Intelpoint Contract was signed by those parties, on July 26, 2010.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 USC §552, on behalf of RBC, I request the following documents:


1. All documents or records relating to the excavation for or construction of the foundations for the two BPA transmission towers in the Bonneville Coulee Line No. 1, identified as "Tower 17/6" (located nearest to the initial alignment of the Project's Dog Creek Bore No. 1), and "Tower 16/3" (located nearest to the initial alignment of the Project's Canyon Bore No. 2). This request includes, without limitation, the BPA Contract under which those two towers were constructed, and any daily reports, diaries, photos of the excavation for or construction of the foundations for those towers by BPA, the Contractor or any subcontractor at any tier.
2. All documents or records containing any information about the subsurface soils conditions at the locations of towers 17/6 and 16/3, including without limitation any

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geotechnical explorations, bore logs or records, geotechnical reports, blasting logs or any other records of the soil conditions during the course of excavation or construction.

Thank you for your cooperation and anticipated prompt response to this request. I am willing to come and review the documents, in advance of copying. If that is not possible, please provide the responsive copies to me, at the address above, or in .pdf format at the email address above. RBC will pay all copy costs up to \$500. Please contact me, if you anticipate that the response will entail costs in excess of \$500.
