BUTTERFISH FISHERY

Trip Limit Reduction
Butterfish catch limited to 5,000 lb per trip or calendar day
Effective Date: 0001 hours, March 18, 2014

Butterfish harvest has now reached the trip limit reduction threshold to move from phase 1 to phase 2 of the directed butterfish fishery based on the 2013 butterfish quota (2014 quotas will go into effect shortly). Since butterfish harvest has reached 50-percent of the 2013 butterfish quota, as of March 18, 2014, vessels issued a longfin squid/butterfish moratorium permit are prohibited from fishing for, catching, possessing, or landing more than 5,000 lb of butterfish per trip or calendar day. The limit for permitted vessels fishing with less than 3-inch mesh remains at 2,500 lb of butterfish per trip or calendar day. The incidental trip limit for butterfish remains at 600 lb. Federally permitted dealers may not purchase more than 5,000 lb of butterfish from federally permitted vessels per trip or per day, beginning at 0001 hours, March 18, 2014.

If or when butterfish harvest is projected to reach the trip limit reduction threshold to move from phase 2 to phase 3, butterfish trip limits for longfin squid/butterfish moratorium permit holders will be reduced to 500 lb (0.23 mt), regardless of mesh size used, through a subsequent action in the <u>Federal Register</u>.
