## Northeast Multispecies Common Pool Vessels

1) Southern New England/Mid-Atlantic Winter Flounder Trip Limit Adjustment *Effective: August 28, 2013, through April 30, 2014* 

The trip limit for Southern New England (SNE)/Mid-Atlantic (MA) winter flounder is decreased for all common pool vessels to **300 lb/trip**.

2) Gulf of Maine Haddock Trip Limit Adjustment *Effective: August 28, 2013, through April 30, 2014* 

The trip limit for Gulf of Maine (GOM) haddock is decreased for all common pool vessels to **0 lb/trip**.

If you have declared your trip through the vessel monitoring system (VMS) or interactive voice response (IVR) system, and crossed the VMS demarcation line prior to August 28, 2013, you will not be subject to the new trip limits for that trip.
