
Northeast Multispecies Recreational Fishermen

Fishing Year 2012 Recreational Fishing Size and Possession Limits *Effective Date: May 1, 2012*

This bulletin announces the Federal size and possession limits for the Northeast multispecies recreational fisheries for fishing year 2012 (May 1, 2012 - April 30, 2013). All limits apply to both private and charter/party recreational vessels, unless otherwise noted. Also, please note the changes for Gulf of Maine cod and contact your local state fisheries office for information on current state regulations.
