LOW INCOME QUALIFYING MEASURE	INSTALLED MEASURE COST PAYMENT - DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR (EXCEPT AS NOTED)	<i>REPAIR COST PAYMENT - DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR (EXAMPLES PROVIDED)</i>

- Outside normal requirements
