Small Entity Compliance Guide

Subject: Inseason Trip Limit Adjustments for Common Pool Vessels for Fishing Year (FY) 2010

Dear Common Pool Northeast (NE) Multispecies Permit Holder:

For common pool vessels fishing under a NE multispecies day-at-sea (DAS), or fishing under a NE multispecies Small Vessel or Handgear A or B category permit:

- Effective immediately, through April 30, 2011, the trip limits are increased for Georges Bank (GB) cod, Cape Cod (CC)/Gulf of Maine (GOM) yellowtail flounder, and Southern New England (SNE)/Mid-Atlantic (MA) yellowtail flounder; and
- Effective 0001 hours April 5, 2011, through April 30, 2011 the trip limits are reduced for GOM cod and GOM winter flounder.

NE multispecies common pool vessels that have submitted the required 48-hour Pre-Trip Notification, declared a trip through the vessel monitoring system (VMS), and crossed the VMS demarcation line prior to 0001 hours April 5, 2011, will not be subject to the new restricted trip limits for that trip, and may land GOM cod and GOM winter flounder under the old trip limit.

Vessels may take advantage of the increased trip limits for GB cod and SNE/MA and CC/GOM yellowtail flounder immediately.



Small Vessel or Handgear A or B Category Permits

This action does not change the current cod trip limit for vessels with a Handgear A (50 lb/trip), Handgear B (25 lb/trip), or Small Vessel Category (75 lb/trip of cod within the limit of 300 lb of cod, haddock, and yellowtail flounder combined) permit. This action does change the GOM winter flounder trip limit for vessels with a Handgear A, Handgear B, or Small Vessel Category permit to 100 lb per trip.
