# SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE

# <u>CHANGES TO VESSEL MONITORING SYSTEM (VMS) REQUIREMENTS</u> <u>FOR FISHING YEAR 2011</u>

Dear Boatracs VMS Vessel Owner:

You will be receiving new macros for your VMS unit this month directly from Boatracs. The macros will be uploaded to the QUALCOMM satellite network on Friday, **April 29, 2011**. Your Boatracs VMS unit should automatically receive the new macros. Please begin using the new macros for any trips you take on or after May 1, 2011.

This letter provides you with specific guidance on how to use your new Boatracs VMS macro screens to comply with approved regulatory changes that are likely to be effective on May 1, 2011.

Other regulatory actions under consideration may be approved following the distribution of this letter. As a result, the macro screens that you view on your Boatracs VMS unit are being updated to include both approved <u>and</u> proposed fishing year 2011 regulatory changes. Any proposed VMS measures that are not ultimately approved may require a future update of your VMS software.

# **REQUIRED VMS MACROS**

Your Boatracs VMS unit must be loaded and running the new NMFS-approved macros by May 1, 2011. The new macros are identified as **Vessel Activity Reports (Declarations) version 13** and **Forms version 7**. The macro version appears at the top of each macro screen.

## **BOATRACS' MACRO DELIVERY PLAN**

Boatracs will provide its Northeast customers with the new NMFS-approved VMS macros. You do not need to have your Boatracs VMS powered up on April 29<sup>th</sup> if your vessel is in port and authorized to power down. Your Boatracs VMS unit should automatically receive the new macros the first time that you power up your VMS on or after April 29<sup>th</sup>. Please confirm that your VMS has received the new macros before declaring and taking your first trip on/after May 1<sup>st</sup>. ## NEW BOATRACS MACRO NUMBERING

The Boatracs macro numbers have <u>changed</u> in order to group the forms macros together based on fishery plan. The new macro list is shown below:

# LIST OF ALL REQUIRED VMS DECLARATIONS AND FORMS SCREENS

Here is a complete listing of <u>all</u> Northeast VMS (macro) screens by fishery management plan. A brief summary of the approved or proposed 2011 changes, if any, are included. Instructions for completing the new and revised Boatracs forms starting May 1, 2011 are provided in **enclosure** (1).

## Multispecies.

- **Multispecies Declaration**. Under the B-DAS Program declaration (Macro 21), the following field has been removed "\_\_ Check to confirm common pool trip".
- Multispecies Catch Report. No longer requires you to enter a 'zero' in fields where no fish were kept. Removes 'windowpane' flounder species from reporting. Adds instructions about negative reports.
- **Trip Start and End Hail.** Combined into one macro. Title drops the word 'Sector' and the instructions refer to use by groundfish vessels. Trip Start Hail adds a new field 'Observer/At-Sea Monitor (ASM) On-Board (Y/N)'. Trip End Hail revises the dealer field to 'Dealer/Offload location'.
- Western Georges Bank and Southern New England Restricted Gear Area (RGA) Notification. Combined into one macro (#37) for common pool vessels.

- **GOM Cod Trip Limit Exemption**. The form now requires common pool vessels to check a box in order to declare their intent and send the form.
- GOM Gillnet Mesh Exemption. NEW FORM. Required by sector vessels if they intend to fish under the 6" gillnet exemption in the GOM Regulated Mesh Area (RMA).

#### Monkfish.

- **Declaration.** No changes.
- Monkfish Trip Limit Overage DAS Adjustment. NEW FORM. Required when exceeding the monkfish daily limit by no more than one extra limit and requesting to be charged the appropriate monkfish DAS to account for the extra limit.

# Scallop.

- Scallop Declaration. Removes the scallop-specific Power Down declaration (LAGC vessels may power down using a new VMS code). Adds 'Hudson Canyon' and 'State Waters Exemption Program' to LAGC and limited access declaration menus. Removes specific access areas from the RSA menu and adds a generic 'Scallop Access Area(s)' declaration. If participating in the State Waters Exemption Program, you may now report through VMS, rather than through the IVR system. Although the Hudson Canyon declaration is included in the menu, this access area remains closed. If Framework 22 is approved, you will be notified of any changes to the access area rotational schedule.
- Scallop Catch Report. Revises the scallop catch report based on new reporting requirements proposed in Amendment 15. These instructions require daily catch reporting within the two yellowtail flounder stock areas. New fields include 'Date Fish Caught', 'GB YT' and 'SNE/MA YT' stock area and 'All Other Fish Kept'. Be aware that these reporting instructions outline requirements that are not yet finalized. Please continue reporting your catch only from access area trips.
- LAGC Scallop Pre-Landing Notification. Allows for the reporting of both 'Meats' and 'Bushels in-shell' if the intent is to land both.
- **Scallop Broken Trip Notification**. The instructions are clarified to specify the two situations when the report should be sent.
- Scallop Access Area Compensation Trip. No changes.

# Herring.

- Herring Declaration. No changes.
- Herring Catch Report. NEW FORM. DO NOT SUBMIT UNTIL NOTIFIED FURTHER. This report, if/when approved, would require daily reporting by all

limited access vessels on a declared herring trip. Please continue to report herring catch through the IVR system until notified otherwise.

• Herring Pre-Landing Notification. Instructions are clarified to require reporting only from CAT A/B vessels using mid-water trawl or purse seine gear on a declared herring trip.

SurfClam, Ocean Quahog & Maine Mahogany Quahog. No changes.

# **Declare Out of Fishery & Power Down.**

• Power Down Declaration. Adds a new Power Down declaration for use while moored/dockside ONLY by LAGC scallop vessels and authorized groundfish sector vessels IF they do not have more restrictive permits requiring 24/7 reporting.

**Scallop Declaration Screen**. Remember - you may not declare into a scallop access area <u>until</u> that area is <u>open</u> to fishing. You may declare into the State Waters Exemption Program as of May 1, 2011; if you have both a limited access and LAGC permit, declare into the exemption program under the 'Limited Access Permit' declaration menu. If you're declaring an RSA trip into one or more scallop access areas open to fishing, you may select 'Scallop Access Area(s)' as of May 1, 2011.



To send a <u>negative</u> daily report, you <u>only</u> need to fill in the 'VTR Serial Number' field.

**Trip Start Hail and Trip End Hail.** These two macros have been combined into a single macro 36. There are three parts to this macro – reading from top to bottom, they are the Trip Start Hail, Trip End Hail, and Additional Required Information.


To send a Trip Start Hail: Enter an 'X' in the field to the left of 'Trip Start Hail' as shown below. Next, enter a 'Y' or 'N' in the Observer/ASM field (this new field may be used to determine whether dockside monitoring is required in 2011 and 2012). Read the 'Note' in the Trip Start Hail section to determine if you are required to complete the 'Estimated Offload' field. Finally, enter information in the fields under 'Additional Required Information' at the bottom of the form.

To send a Trip End Hail: Enter an 'X' in the field to the left of 'Trip End Hail' as shown below. Next, complete the five fields that follow. For the 'Dealer/ Offload Location' field, state either the dealer or the offload location if different than the dealer location. If you will only conduct one offload on the trip, leave blank the 'Second Offload State' and 'Second Offload Port City' fields. Finally, enter information in the fields under 'Additional Required Information' at the bottom of the form.




**Restricted Gear Area Notification**. Two macros have been combined into a single macro 37. This form is required to be sent by Common Pool vessels only, before leaving port, if intending to fish all or part of the trip within one of the restricted gear areas (RGA).



## **NE Multispecies Regulated Mesh Areas**







**Gulf of Maine Gillnet Mesh Exemption.** This form is required by groundfish sector vessels only. To declare this NMFS-authorized sector exemption from the GOM gear restriction, you must check the box and send the form before leaving port. Refer to the chart on the previous page for a view of the GOM RMA.



**Monkfish Trip Limit Overage DAS Adjustment.** All three fields are required to be filled in before sending the form. The form must be sent before the trip ends (before crossing the VMS demarcation line) so that NMFS automated processes associate the DAS adjustment request with the trip dates. The DAS charge for the trip is automatically adjusted.



**Scallop Catch Report.** The scallop catch report form has been updated to reflect changes that would occur if Amendment 15 to the Scallop fishery management plan is approved. However, until you have been notified by NMFS of the approval and implementation of Amendment 15, you are only required to send this daily report when declared into a scallop access area and only the following fields are required: VTR, Scallop Meats Kept, Yellowtail Kept, and Yellowtail Discarded. Since reporting by Yellowtail Stock Area is not currently required, you should enter the species kept/discarded information in the 'GB YT' column only.

# **MACRO 41**

These instructions are based on new reporting requirements proposed in Amendment 15. Until further notice, you are only required to submit this form when on a declared access area trip.




If Amendment 15 is approved, you will also need to fill in the two 'All Other\* Fish Kept' fields. Be sure to exclude scallop and yellowtail flounder from the total in these fields.

**LAGC Scallop Pre-Landing Notification**. Read the 'Instructions' and the 'Note' at the bottom of the macro to determine whether you must send this form before returning to port. 


