Small Entity Compliance Guide

Dear Scallop Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that the limited access general category (LAGC) scallop fishery is closed to individual fishing quota (IFQ) scallop vessels effective 0001 hours, January 18, 2010. This action is being taken in accordance with the Atlantic sea scallop regulations at 50 CFR 648.53(a)(8)(iii) to prevent the IFQ scallop vessels from exceeding the total allowable catch (TAC) during the fourth quarter of the 2009 fishing year ending February 28, 2010. The IFQ scallop fleet was allocated an annual TAC of 4,590,024 lb for the 2009 fishing year.

The permit holder letter dated November 19, 2009, stated that approximately 471,962 lb remained for the fourth quarter and that number would increase/decrease based on landings updates that occur regularly. The quota has been harvested, based on reports of landings this quarter and late reports from previous quarters.

Therefore, beginning 0001 hours on January 18, 2010, no IFQ scallop vessel fishing under LAGC regulations may declare its intent to enter the fishery and may not fish for, possess, or retain any scallops. This closure applies to vessels issued an IFQ permit and to vessels issued Letters of Authorization to fish under appeal. The LAGC scallop fishery is scheduled to re-open to IFQ scallop vessels on March 1, 2010.
