Dear Federal Fisheries Permit Holder:

NOAA is aware that the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe, or members thereof, are asserting that they, and possibly those for whom they fish or operate a vessel, are not subject to the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (Magnuson-Stevens Act) and all Federal regulations while fishing in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ). Although NOAA is exploring, in government-to-government discussions with the Tribe, the basis for these assertions, NOAA, at this time, does not recognize any claims that Passamaquoddy tribal members are not subject to Federal fishing laws and regulations.

NOAA, therefore, reminds all persons, vessels, and vessel owners, regardless of their affiliation with the Passamaquoddy Tribe, that the Magnuson-Stevens Act and Federal fishing regulations apply to all fishermen while fishing in the EEZ. Any vessel fishing or possessing federally regulated species in or from the EEZ, and any person purchasing, possessing, or receiving for a commercial purpose any federally regulated species from the vessels fishing in the EEZ, must hold a valid Federal permit and comply with all Federal fishing regulations. This includes any federally regulated species caught in the EEZ and landed on Passamaquoddy reservation land. Additionally, NOAA reminds all persons, vessels, and vessels owners, that they are subject to the provisions of the Marine Mammal Protection Act, and the Endangered Species Act, regardless of their affiliation with the Passamaquoddy Tribe.

Any member of the Passamaquoddy Tribe who acts in violation of Federal fishing laws at this time risks seizure and forfeiture of any species illegally harvested as well as possible related charges. Anyone who is not a member of the Tribe can anticipate facing such consequences even if it were later determined that tribal members, including those fishing from or operating boats owned by others, are exempt from any fishing laws.
