SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE

CLOSURE OF THE DIRECTED BUTTERFISH FISHERY

Dear Atlantic Mackerel, Squid, and/or Butterfish Permit Holder:

NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service has determined that 80 percent of the butterfish quota for the 2008 fishing year has been harvested. Therefore, **effective 0001 hours**, **September 5**, **2008**, the directed fishery for butterfish is closed and vessels issued Federal permits for butterfish may not retain or land more than 250 lb of butterfish per trip or per calendar day. The directed fishery will reopen at 0001 hours, January 1, 2009, at which time the 2009 quota for the butterfish fishery will become available.
