SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE


CLOSURE OF THE TRIMESTER II DIRECTED LOLIGO SQUID FISHERY

Dear Atlantic Mackerel, Squid, and/or
Butterfish Permit Holder:

NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service has determined that 90 percent of the Loligo squid Trimester II quota for 2008 has been harvested. Therefore, **effective 0001 hours, July 17, 2008, the directed fishery for Loligo squid is closed and vessels issued Federal permits for Loligo squid may not retain or land more than 2,500 lb of Loligo squid per trip or per calendar day. The directed fishery will reopen at 0001 hours, September 1, 2008, at which time the 2008 Trimester III quota for the Loligo squid fishery will become available.**
