SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE

Dear Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that NOAA Fisheries Service is replacing the current Days-at-Sea (DAS) call-in system with a new Interactive Voice Response (IVR) call-in system. **Effective June 1, 2006, you will be required to use this new IVR call-in system to manage your DAS requirements unless you are required to or have elected to use the vessel monitoring system (VMS) for this purpose.** The old operator-based call-in system will no longer be available after May 31, 2006.

While the current system collects DAS information by telephone operators at an offsite facility, the new IVR system will collect the same DAS information submitted by you through your telephone's keypad. This initiative is expected to provide faster service to the user and will result in significant cost savings to the taxpayer. Under this new system, you will call a toll-free telephone number, enter your 6-digit Federal fisheries permit number and a unique NOAA Fisheries Service-assigned personal identification number (PIN) and, through a series of IVR prompts and your responses, obtain a sailing, landing or block confirmation number.

This letter summarizes the new method by which the IVR call-in DAS notifications must be provided to NOAA Fisheries Service beginning June 1, 2006. The regulatory requirements have not changed -- only the method by which this information is collected has changed. The regulatory text that governs the call-in notification requirements may be found at 50 CFR 648.10(c). A copy of the regulations may also be requested by calling 978-281-9315 or can be found on the web at www.nero.noaa.gov/sfd/. For questions about this new IVR call-in system, please contact the NOAA Fisheries Service Office of Law Enforcement, at (978) 281-9213. You may also e-mail your questions or concerns about the IVR system to nmfs.ole.ne@noaa.gov.

On June 1, 2006, you are required to use the IVR call-in system unless you are required to or have elected to use the vessel monitoring system (VMS) for this purpose. The toll-free telephone number for this new system is **1-888-284-4904**. **There is one exception to the June 1, 2006 implementation date: You must use the new IVR call-in system before June 1, 2006 to obtain a sailing confirmation if you should sail before June 1st and plan to land on or after June 1st.**

In order to begin using the new system, you must use your 6-digit Federal fisheries permit number and a unique PIN, which is being provided to you in the attachment. Please safeguard your assigned PIN as you would any other PIN for security purposes. The IVR system will determine if there is a match between the permit number and PIN. If there is a match, the system will allow you to continue in order to obtain your sailing, landing or block confirmation number. If there is no match between the permit number and PIN, the IVR system will terminate the telephone call after three attempts; you will be unable to fish until you call the Office of Law Enforcement and provide the



information identified in paragraph 9 of the attachment entitled “IVR Days-At-Sea Call-In System: Initial Prompts.”

If you lose or misplace your PIN, or need to have your PIN changed, contact the NOAA Fisheries Service Office of Law Enforcement at (978) 281-9213, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Confirmation of your PIN or assignment of a new PIN will be provided to you by letter only. For security reasons, PINs will not be provided over the telephone.

If ownership of the vessel changes, the PIN previously assigned to that vessel will be automatically canceled. The Office of Law Enforcement will mail a letter with the new PIN to the new vessel owner.


This letter includes four attachments as summarized below, which will help you to understand the new system:

1. Your assigned PIN, which will only work in conjunction with your Federal fisheries permit number;
2. An explanation of the initial prompts that you will hear when you call the IVR system and the responses you will need to provide;
3. A worksheet that provides helpful telephone numbers and additional space for you to enter other information that you may find useful when calling the IVR system; and
4. A list of 3-digit port codes for the Northeast Region. You will need to know your port code before calling the IVR system.

IVR DAYS-AT-SEA CALL-IN SYSTEM: INITIAL PROMPTS

1. The following is a brief explanation of how the new IVR system will operate and how it prompts you for the required information:

2. The IVR system will answer each call as follows:

“Hello, this is NOAA’s National Marine Fisheries Service. You’ve reached the interactive response call-in service. Be advised that knowingly and willfully reporting false information through this system is a criminal violation of federal law under 18 USC 1001.

Press 1 for Days at Sea reporting;

Press 2 for Vessel Trip reporting;

Press 3 for Research Set Aside reporting;

Press 4 for Exempted Fishing reporting.”

3. Your response for Days-at-Sea reporting will be to press “1” on your telephone key pad. The IVR will then prompt you as follows:

“Enter your Permit Number”

4. Once you enter your 6-digit Federal fisheries permit number, the IVR will prompt you for your PIN as follows:

“Please enter your PIN. If you do not have a PIN, have lost your PIN, or experience other problems with this system, please contact the Office of Law Enforcement at 978-281-9213, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. After hours, call the Office of Law Enforcement toll-free back-up line at 1-888-487-9994 and provide the following information: your name, call back phone number, problem experienced, vessel name, federal fisheries permit number, port, and reason for your call (for example, to obtain your sailing, landing or block confirmation). This message will repeat in 5 seconds.”

5. If you have entered your permit number and PIN correctly, the IVR will continue to prompt you as follows:

“Please state your name and operator number after the beep. Press the pound sign when you are finished.”

6. The system will ask if you wish to re-record your name and operator number. Once you have completed this step, the system will then ask:

“Press 1 to report sailing;

Press 2 to report landing;

Press 3 for a block entry.”

7. From this point, you will press the appropriate number (1, 2, or 3) and respond to the IVR system prompts in order to obtain your confirmation number. All sailing and block telephone calls will also require you to enter a 3-digit Port Code; these codes are provided in the attachments.

8. As with the current call-in system, the IVR system will provide you a 6-digit confirmation number of your sailing, landing or block information. You should safeguard this confirmation number in case you receive any inquiries about your activity from NOAA Fisheries Service, U. S. Coast Guard, or State law enforcement.

9. If for any reason you are unable to access the IVR system or are unable to obtain a confirmation of your activity from the IVR system, call the NOAA Fisheries Service Office of Law Enforcement as described below.

You may not sail on a fishing trip until you take one of the following actions; you must follow this procedure for your sailing, landing or block confirmation.

a. Normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm (EDT/EST): Call the Northeast Region Office of Law Enforcement at (978) 281-9213.

b. After business hours: Call the Office of Law Enforcement toll-free back-up line at 1-888-IVR-9994 (1-888-487-9994) and provide the following information: (1) your name, (2) your call back phone number, (3) a brief explanation of the problem you are experiencing with the IVR system, (4) vessel name, (5) federal fisheries permit number, (6) sailing or landing port, and (7) reason for your call (for example, to obtain a sailing, landing or block confirmation). **For sailings, you may sail once you have provided this information.**

You are reminded that the back-up line is only to be used in the event that you are unable to use the IVR system because of problems with the system or your PIN. Please note that NOAA Fisheries Service enforcement agents will be capable of remotely accessing the information you provide to the back-up line to verify that the call-in requirement was met. Your information will be reviewed by the Office of Law Enforcement staff on the next available working day and a manual modification will be made to the IVR/DAS database, as appropriate.

As explained above, the NOAA Fisheries Service Office of Law Enforcement staff must make a manual modification to the IVR/DAS database whenever you are unable to obtain a confirmation from the IVR and you must instead contact the staff or use the back-up line. If you sail using the back-up line after business hours and intend to land the same trip before the next working day, the IVR system will not recognize your landing because it will have no record of your sailing. You will need to call the back-up line for your landing.
