SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE


Dear Bluefish Dealer and
Commercial Vessel Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that the Atlantic bluefish commercial quota available to New York has been harvested.

Effective **0001 hours on December 12, 2006**, fishing vessels issued a Federal commercial permit for the bluefish fishery may no longer land bluefish in New York for the remainder of the 2006 calendar year. Vessel owners issued Federal permits are also reminded that they must continue to complete and submit vessel logbooks. Additionally, dealers issued Federal dealer permits for bluefish are advised that they may not purchase bluefish from federally permitted vessels that land in New York for the remainder of the calendar year. Federally permitted dealers must also continue to report all fish purchases from any vessel.
