SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE

CLOSURE OF THE QUARTER II DIRECTED LOLIGO SQUID FISHERY

Dear Atlantic Mackerel, Squid, and/or Butterfish Permit Holder:

NMFS has determined that 80 percent of the <u>Loligo</u> squid Quarter II quota for 2006 has been harvested. Therefore, **effective 0001 hours**, **May 23, 2006**, **the directed fishery for <u>Loligo</u>** squid is closed and vessels issued Federal permits for <u>Loligo</u> squid may not retain or land more than 2,500 lb of <u>Loligo</u> squid per trip or per calendar day. The directed fishery will reopen at 0001 hours, July 1, 2006, at which time the 2006 Quarter III quota for the <u>Loligo</u> squid fishery will become available.
