## Small Entity Compliance Guide

Dear Multispecies Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that as of July 4, 2002, pursuant to 50 CFR 648.86(a)(1)(iii)(B), the daily haddock trip limit for vessels fishing under a limited access multispecies dayat-sea (DAS) permit is adjusted. The daily trip limit is suspended from 0001 hours on July 4, 2002, through 0001 hours on April 30, 2003, unless you are otherwise notified. The maximum haddock trip limit allowed per trip is 30,000 lb for the period from July 4, 2002, through September 30, 2002, and 50,000 lb per trip for the period from October 1, 2002, through April 30, 2003. Therefore, the amount of haddock on board will not be counted on a DAS basis, but vessels are still subject to the respective haddock trip limit per trip for each of the time periods stated above.

This adjustment is being enacted as specified in the Northeast multispecies regulations to provide the industry with the opportunity to harvest at least 75 percent of the total allowable catch of haddock for the fishing year.

This small entity compliance guide complies with section 212 of the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement and Fairness Act of 1996.
