Dear Spiny Dogfish Dealer and Commercial Vessel Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that the spiny dogfish commercial quota available to the coastal states from Maine to Florida for the fishing year 2001 period 2 (November-April) has been harvested.

Therefore, effective November 21, 2001, fishing vessels issued a Federal permit for the spiny dogfish fishery <u>may no longer land spiny</u> <u>dogfish</u> for the duration of period 2 (through April 30, 2002). Vessel owners issued Federal permits are reminded that they must continue to complete and submit vessel logbooks. Additionally, dealers issued Federal dealer permits for spiny dogfish are advised that they <u>may not purchase spiny dogfish from federally permitted</u> <u>spiny dogfish vessels</u> for the duration of period 2 (through April 30, 2002). Federally permitted dealers must continue to report **all** fish purchases from **any** vessel.

The Northeast Regional Office has established two automated systems to provide faster notice to the fishing industry of management actions.
