REMINDER: Monkfish Minimum Size Limit

Dear Monkfish Dealer:

This letter is to remind you of the monkfish minimum size limits in effect for the Northern Fishery Management Area (NFMA) and the Southern Fishery Management Area (SFMA).

- For vessels declared into the NFMA, the minimum fish size is <u>17 inches total length</u>, or <u>11 inches tail length</u>. Such vessels must have available for inspection a valid Letter of Authorization exempting the vessel from the minimum fish size of the SFMA. This size limit applies to vessels holding a limited access monkfish permit, and to vessels holding an incidental monkfish permit that wish to fish under the less restrictive size limit of the NFMA.
- For vessels fishing in the SFMA or not declared into the NFMA, the minimum fish size is <u>21 inches total length</u>, or <u>14 inches tail length</u>.

This letter is only a summary of part of the monkfish regulations found at 50 CFR §648.91 et seq.
