Adoption of Revisions to Procedural Metadata Standards

Revisions to the Service's Geospatial and Biological Metadata Standards have successfully completed the formal national review process for proposed data standards and are hereby formally adopted. No negative comments or suggested modifications were received from Service personnel during the formal 45-day review period, ending on September 27, 2007.

This purpose of these revised standards is to simplify the internal metadata creation process and ensure complete alignment with the Federal Geographic Data Committee's Content Standard for Digital Geospatial Metadata (CSDGM), FGDC-STD-001-1998, and the Biological Data Profile of the CSDGM.
