We write in response to Reclamation's publication of a draft Finding of No Significant Impact and Final Environmental Assessment for the Pilot Operation of the Yuma Desalting Plant. We are pleased to see the commitment of the new administration to protecting the environment in the Colorado River Delta as evidenced by the binational agreement to replace water flowing to the Cienega de Santa Clara that will be lost due to the pilot operation of the Yuma Desalting Plant. We are hopeful this represents the beginning of a new era of cooperation between the United States and Mexico that results in additional habitat restoration in the Colorado River Delta.
