



## Recommendations arising from the Caribbean Regional Wildlife Enforcement Workshop

20- 22 July 2016, Nassau, the Bahamas

1. Creation of a Caribbean Wildlife Enforcement Network (CaribWEN)
2. UNODC to make publically available the statement of outcomes.
3. The outcomes of the workshop will be presented at the 2<sup>nd</sup> global meeting of the wildlife enforcement networks to take place 28-29 September in Johannesburg, South Africa.
4. The participants of the workshop will advocate for the creation of a Caribbean Wildlife Enforcement Network.
5. The participants agreed to promote the inclusion and discussion of wildlife trafficking as a priority in regional fora, such as CARIFORUM.
6. The participants agreed that each country will identify and inform UNODC of a focal point for a CaribWEN no later than September 30 2016.
7. The identified focal points shall meet virtually in January 2017 and should make recommendations on the next steps towards operationalisation of a CaribWEN no later than February 2017.
