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| <p><b>Roberts:</b> We wanted to go over Recommendation 16-02 that we talked about at the board meeting last week. Did you have any questions? Joel or Greg could you explain what a closure site is?</p> | <p><b>Bradburne:</b> All of our contractors are on a fixed term, usually five years, but it is funded annually. A closure site would be a fixed scope of work. The sooner you finish a job it would save money so that would be an incentive to finish sooner. With that, there is commitment by the government that they will guarantee a certain amount of money every single year so you do not go through this funding fluctuation with how much money you get every year. It is a fixed scope of work over some reasonable time period. Then you would know when the work will be done.</p> |
| <p><b>Smalley:</b> Would you think the sooner we put this recommendation out there the better it would be?</p>   | <p><b>Bradburne:</b> I would think so, if you don't pass it in November you probably missed this year's window. Everybody is talking about the federal budget. As soon as it passes they start worrying about everything else.</p>   |
| <p><b>Berry:</b> If we could get this program started maybe by the time the barter has run out, I think it would be great. It all takes time. I think this is our best option.</p>                       |  |
