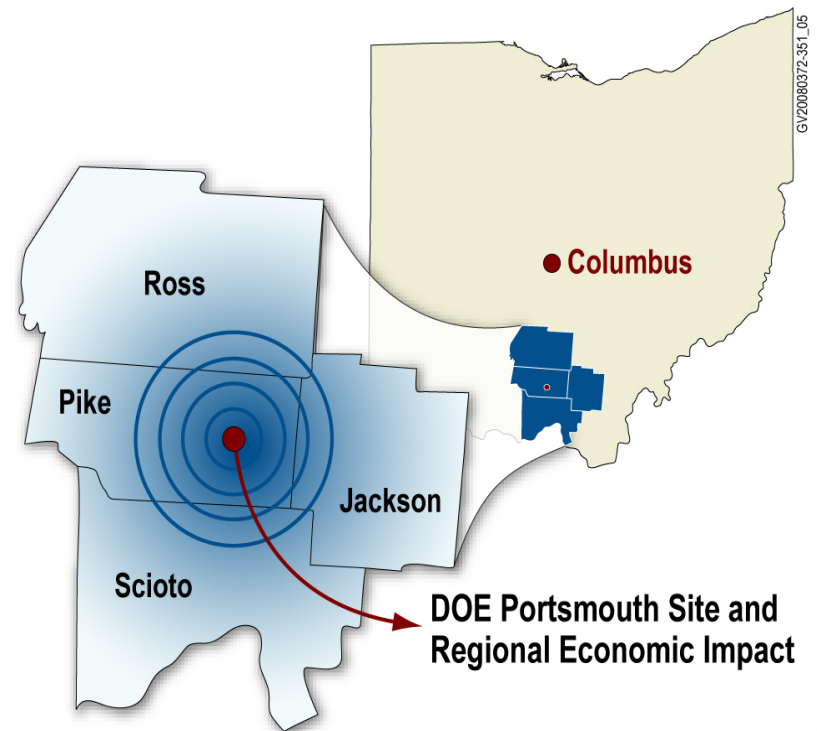
Educational Outreach

12-week program: June – August

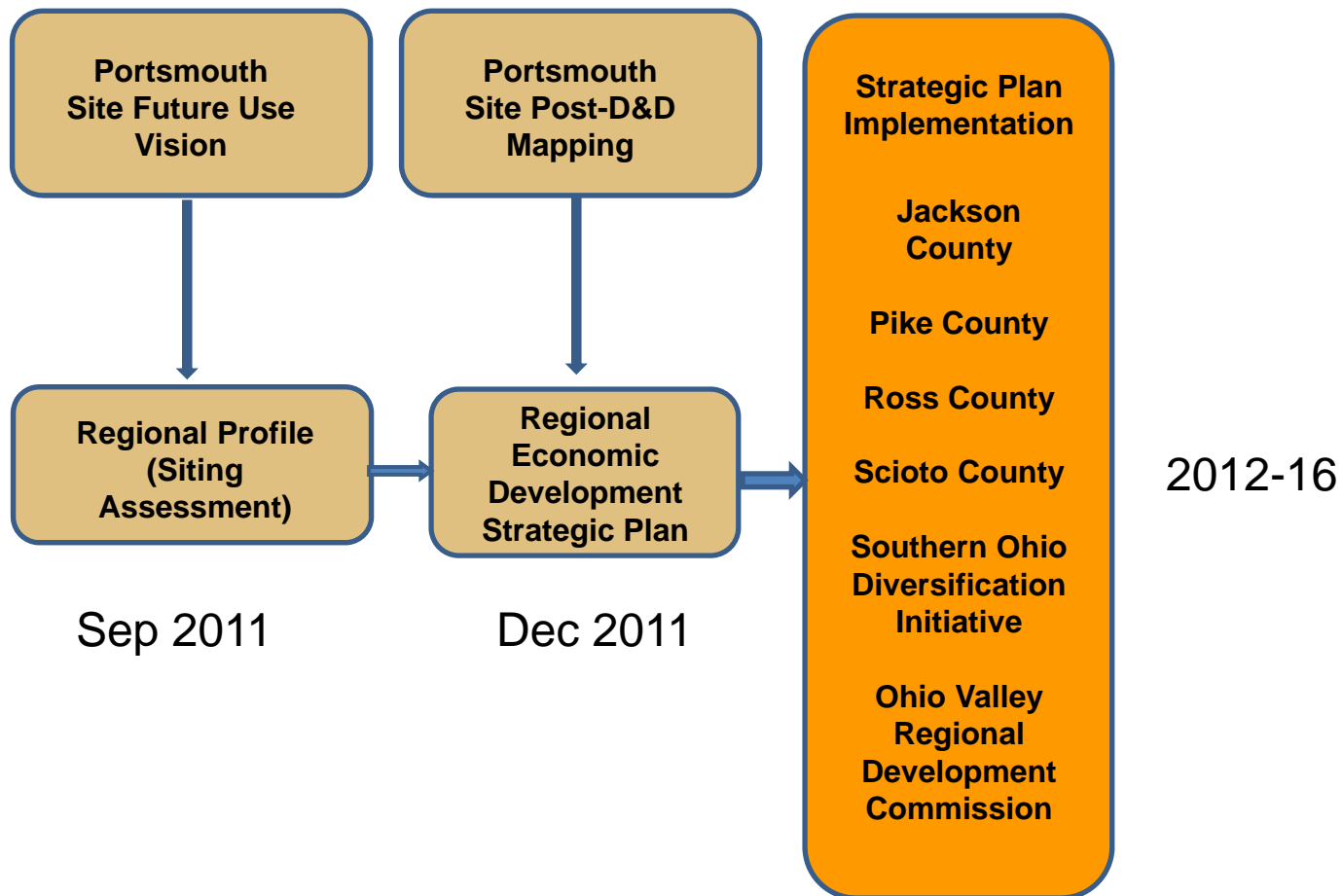
Economic Development Support On Track
