Entrants must be between the ages of 5 - 18 by Sept. 30, 2016

Only 1 entry per person

Arwork must be original recent work, not computer generated, scanned or traced.

Can be a drawing or painting. If you mix mediums, classify your entry as one or another.

Subject matter must represent native Louisiana wildlife found on a Louisiana National Wildlife Refuge. No exotic species.

Only native plants. animals, habitats, and landscapes accepted.

Artwork entered in a previous year cannot be re-entered.

Artwork MUST BE matted.
Artwork must NOT be framed or have name, initials or title on front.

\*Velcro wil be affixed to the back of entry for hanging

Entrants are responsible for picking up their art by October 31 at COB (4:00pm). After this time, art will become the property of the USFWS.
