

Education Trunks

The following education trunks are FREE for use in schools, nature centers, and other informal settings. Pick-up and drop-off trunks at the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Office, 203 W. 2nd St. Grand Island, NE. Birds of Nebraska Trunk - contains literature books, videos, teacher activity guides, classroom activities, and other resources such as feathers, feet, birding by ear CD's, posters, and field guides.

Bridge to Birding Trunk- contains 20 pairs of binoculars, fields guides, Flying WILD activity guide, and a binder full of Nebraska-specific bird information.



Threatened & Endangered Species Trunk

-contains literature books, videos, teacher activity guides, classroom activities, pelts, egg and skull replicas, stuffed animals, felt story boards, and field guides.

Crane Trunk - contains literature books, videos, classroom activities, and other resources such as crane feathers, feet and crane egg (replica).

Mammals of Nebraska Trunk- contains literature books, videos, teacher activity guides, classroom activities, and other resources such as pelts, skulls, posters and field guides.
