Introduction

The Office of Hydrogen, Fuel Cells and Infrastructure Technologies is pleased to announce the upcoming Hydrogen and Fuel Cells Summit VIII. For the first time, the Summit will be held outside of the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area, relocating to the University of Miami.

Summit Topics

In its eighth year, the Summit will continue its history of strong support for industry through the following activities, which will involve presentations, breakout sessions and open discussions:

- Status reports on RD&D in the areas of stationary, portable, and vehicular fuel cell technologies, domestic and international
- Status reports on safety, codes and standards activities related to hydrogen fuels
- > Status reports on remaining institutional issues and possible responses to them
- > Identification of action items and formation of voluntary teams to address them.

Additionally, the change of venue allows us to offer an informative seminar on day three of the Summit, which will be jointly conducted by Dr. Michael Swain of the University of Miami and Dr. Jay Keller of Sandia National Laboratory. This seminar will include lectures and demonstrations of the lean flammability and safety setback projects being used to verify the physical properties of gaseous hydrogen for development of standards.
