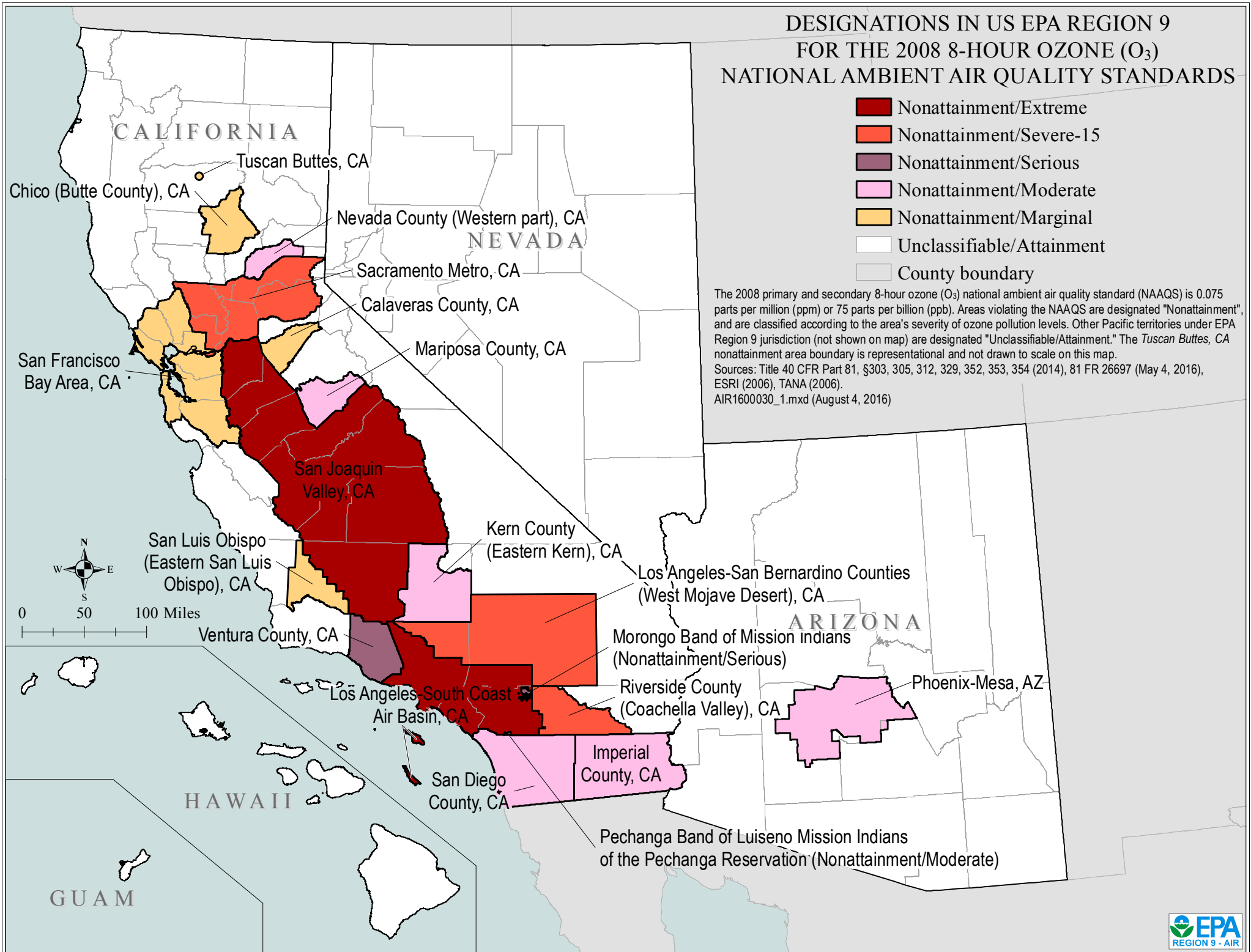


DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 2008 8-HOUR OZONE (O₃) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

The 2008 primary and secondary 8-hour ozone (O₃) national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) is 0.075 parts per million (ppm) or 75 parts per billion (ppb). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment", and are classified according to the area's severity of ozone pollution levels. Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment." The *Tuscan Buttes, CA* nonattainment area boundary is representational and not drawn to scale on this map.
