U.S. diesel fuel prices continue to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$2.91 a gallon on Memorial Day Monday. That's up a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.17 a gallon, up 1.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Midwest and Gulf Coast states at 2.80 a gallon.
