Diesel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.98 a gallon. That's down 1.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.26 a gallon, down 2.4 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 3.80 a gallon, up 4-tenths of a penny.
