Diesel prices increase for first time in six weeks

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$3.83 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 3.97 a gallon, down 6-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.73 a gallon, up 1.9 cents.
